58TH MONTREUX JAZZ FESTIVAL

The historic "off premises" edition kicks off today

The 58th Montreux Jazz Festival begins today! From 5 to 20 July, the public will be able to discover a completely redesigned version of the event, featuring a record number of terraces and stages. The Lake Stage will be inaugurated tonight to the rhythms of New Orleans, while the Casino Stage will reveal two future pop stars. Music fans from all over the world will also be able to experience the Festival from afar: over thirty concerts will be broadcast live and free of charge on YouTube.

For the past few weeks, Montreux has been the scene of a vast and meticulously choreographed event. The terraces are emerging from the water, the stages are setting in their new quarters, the food stalls and bars are multiplying on the lakeside, the Rylsee characters are swarming everywhere, and the majestic Lake Stage is becoming a little more integrated into the Montreux landscape every day. The 'outside the walls' edition of the Festival, which the teams have been planning up for several months, is finally taking shape before our very eyes.

From today onwards, the festivalgoers will be able to immerse themselves in the Festival's completely redesigned itinerary, with more terraces and venues than ever before. The inauguration of the Lake Stage promises to be explosive, with a 100% New Orleans evening featuring **Trombone Shorty** and **Jon Batiste**. At the Casino, two future pop stars, **Henry Moodie** and **Lauren Spencer Smith**, will be following in the footsteps of the legends who came before them at this iconic venue. At the same time, the free programme will be in full swing from 5pm, with a packed programme of DJ sets, concerts, workshops, screenings and other events. In all, more than thirty activities await festival-goers every day.
